## The Mission

To build leadership skills & enhance awareness of business, government and civic issues through interaction and direct involvement with business and community leaders.

## Program Outcomes

- ◆ Get exclusive introductions to the people and places making up the very core of the Rockford Region.
- ◆ Interact with emerging leaders and people firmly established in positions of influence.
- ◆ Learn tools to develop self-awareness and participate in activities that enhance your leadership skills.
- ◆ Gain encouragement and motivation to get involved in business and community leadership.

These are all integral components of Leadership Rockford (*formerly known as the CAP Program*), an eight-month program of panel and group discussions, business and community tours, community projects and leadership skills training.

## The Curriculum

Class members meet two times per month, typically on Fridays at 7:30 a.m. The eight-month program includes:

- ◆ An all-day opening retreat
- ◆ Occasional Thursday afternoon sessions
- ◆ An all-day trip to Springfield, IL
- ◆ A group community service project

The first session, an all-day retreat, covers personality profiles that increase understanding, empathy and communication skills. We will also discuss teaches facilitation skills to maximize each participant's experiences over the next eight months.

Whether a life-long resident of the community or a newcomer, Leadership Rockford provides each participant with an in-depth understanding of the local community, including its history, successes and future.

## The Certificate



In partnership with Judson University, participants in Leadership Rockford have the opportunity to earn an academic Certificate in Community Leadership (12 credits). Additional requirements would need to be met, and the cost for the certificate is \$500. For more information, contact Jennifer Mattingly, Judson University, at 815.399.3500.

## The Participants

Emerging leaders who have already displayed a high level of leadership are selected to participate in the program. Leadership Rockford is a great program for individuals new to the community, newly promoted in their place of business, or just eager to become more involved in the Rockford Region. Members of the class represent a wide range of backgrounds: business, government, social services, the arts, and many others. The diversity of the class forms a dynamic cross-section of personal and professional viewpoints and perspectives.

Leadership Rockford begins in early-October with an all-day retreat. The program requires a serious commitment from both the participants and their employers or sponsors. In order to graduate from the program, a participant must have 100 percent attendance of the class sessions. Any missed sessions will require a "make-up" session.

## Tuition
