 - **Leadership Characteristics**
Describe the candidate's leadership characteristics that have proven instrumental to the candidate's success and will contribute to her future success.
 - **Community Contributions**
Describe the candidate's contributions to the community. How does this person share their time and/or talents to make the Rockford region a better place?

- 4) Please include the candidate's name, place of work, title, email address and phone number in the nomination.
