

2025 Community Hero Award

The **Community Hero Award** is designed to honor a female's contributions outside of the office. The honoree should demonstrate a commitment to her community through service. This individual should have contributed positively to community improvement and change through time, talent, treasure or a combination. Her skills should be utilized in a way that does not directly benefit her professionally, but rather, for the betterment of others. The Nominee must be a member of the Greater Rockford Chamber of Commerce. Nominations may be self-submitted or submitted by another person/organization.

The award will be presented at the Women-in-Business Luncheon as part of **Pow(H)er** 2025 at Embassy Suites by Hilton Rockford Riverfront & Rockford Conference Center.

Entry Process

- Prepare a written submission that addresses the following:
 - 1. Nominee's name, place of work, title, email address and phone number
 - 2. Nominator's name, place of work, title, email address and phone number
 - 3. Start With Why

It's often said less is more. In a quick 250-word summary, share *why* your nominee should be named Community Hero.

4. Community Improvement

In what way has this person's contributions positively improved, impacted or changed the community for the better? (Data to showcase improvement welcomed & encouraged, but not required)

5. Servant Leadership

In what ways does the nominee demonstrate servant leadership? How does her work directly benefit the community?

6. Professional and/or Personal Responsibilities

Describe the nominee's life beyond her volunteer work – professionally and/or personally.

• Letters of recommendation will be accepted & considered but are not required.
